

# Perfectly Pretty Pillowcases

WOF = width of fabric

Use a 1/2" seam allowance throughout.

<u>Yardage:</u>				
Pillowcase	1/2 yard	7/8 yard	1 1/8 yard	1 5/8 yard
Cuff	1/4 yard	1/4 yard	1/4 yard	1/4 yard
Trim	1/8 yard	1/8 yard	1/8 yard	1/8 yard
<u>Cut the following:</u>				
Pillowcase	17" X 28"	29" X WOF	36" X WOF	55" X WOF
Cuff	8" X 28"	9" X WOF	9" X WOF	9" X WOF
Trim	1 3/4" X 28"	2" X WOF	2" X WOF	2" X WOF

Fold trim fabric in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. Press with raw edges together. Repeat with cuff fabric.

Lay pillowcase fabric on flat surface, right side up. Place the raw edges of the trim piece along one of the long, raw edges of the pillowcase. Place raw edges of the cuff fabric along the edge of the pillowcase/trim fabric. Pin in place and sew (Diagram 1.) Finish edge with a zig-zag stitch or your favorite method. Press trim and cuff away from pillowcase. Trim the side edges even, removing selvage edge.

Fold pillowcase in half, right sides together, following diagram. Sew along short and long edge of the pillowcase (Diagram 2.) Finish edges with a zig-zag stitch or your favorite method.

Turn and press (Diagram 3.)
